City Heights Canyons Loop Trail Hike

Saturday, March 19, at 2:00 p.m.

Meet at Ocean Discovery Institute (4255 Thorn Street) for a guided hike of Manzanita Canyon, a part of the 5-mile City Heights Canyons Loop Trail, led by San Diego Canyonlands. This 2 mile, approximately 1 hour hike will cover a variety of terrain, some steep, so please wear appropriate footwear. The tour will end with a walk through the Azalea Park Water Conservation Garden to Poplar Street, where you can stroll the Azalea Park Art Walk to make your way back to the Manzanita Gathering Place, with stairs down to Ocean Discovery Institute.

Sunday, March 20, at 1:00 p.m.

Meet at Manzanita Gathering Place (at the crossing of Manzanita Place and Manzanita Drive, near 4358 Manzanita Drive) for a guided hike of the Manzanita Canyon, part of the 5-mile City Heights Canyons Loop Trail, led by City Heights Canyons Loop Trail steward Linda Pennington. This 2 mile, approximately one hour

hike will cover a variety of terrain, some steep, so please wear appropriate footwear. The tour will showcase art elements along the trail and at the Azalea Park Water Conservation Garden. A walk along Poplar Street will showcase how local art has played a leading role in this community, with mosaics, murals, and an entry monument.
